





WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for the Township of East Brunswick Fire District No.3 (the "Fire District") for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of November 18, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.) [*Include the following as appropriate: [includes a proposed public referendum in the amount of \$ _____ in excess of the allowable amount to be raised by taxation][includes a proposed public referendum in the amount of \$ _____ as an appropriation from restricted fund balance to be used as budget revenue]*]; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$675,537, which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$638,148, and Total Appropriations of \$675,537; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on November 18, 2014 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District will consider the Annual Budget for adoption on January 13, 2015.





The total 2015 proposed budget has increased in the amount of \$51,690 compared to the 2014 adopted budget. The only line item that exceeds the +/-10% variance would be "Reserve for future capital outlays" in the amount of \$60,000. This amount is for a new chief truck.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unrestricted Fund Balance(s). Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. If Unrestricted Fund Balance is reduced by more than 10%, explain the projected impact on the following year's budget.

There is an increase in the amount to be raised by taxation in this proposed budget of approximately \$16,690. There is no utilization of the restricted fund balances. There is utilization of unreserved fund balances in the amount of \$35,000. The tax rate will be increased .006 to .281.

3. Include a statement explaining how the Fire District is complying with the Property Tax Levy Cap. The statement must explain reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the Fire District to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum.

This proposed budget is within the guidelines of the Property Tax Levy Cap without utilizing any of the prior year cap bank.

4. If the Fire District plans to pass a Resolution for the Release of Restricted Fund Balance, explain the reason and purposes of the appropriation.

There are plans to possibly pass a resolution for the release of unrestricted funds for the purchase of a new command vehicle.

5. Complete a brief statement on the Annual Budget's proposed capital appropriations and payment methods, including debt service for the proposed budget year and for future years.

There is an increase in the capital appropriations in the amount of \$60,000 for Reserved for Future Capital Outlay. There is a debt service appropriation for the principal and interest payment on an intergovernmental loan for the improvement of an existing firehouse. The first draw of \$500,000 has an interest rate of 0.6% with a suggested repayment of \$100,000 per year for five years.
